Prométhéa Voyages evaluates its partner excursion companies according to the following criteria:

- ❖ **Care for people:** **respectful** working conditions (salary, working hours, breaks, rights, etc.)
- ❖ **Plastic-free policy:** **reusable** dishes, **refills**, etc.
- ❖ **Waste management:** minimum **sorting** of organic and plastic waste
- ❖ **Energy efficiency:** use of **low energy appliances**
- ❖ **Child protection:** **children's rights are strictly respected**
- ❖ **Local supplies:** purchase of **local** food products produced according to the **principles of sustainability and fair trade**
- ❖ **Respect of biodiversity:** wild species are not **harvested, consumed, exhibited, sold or exchanged** outside of current regulations
- ❖ **Authentic charm:** integration of **architectural elements** and **local cultural heritage**
- ❖ **Community values:** **respecting and supporting the intellectual property rights of local communities**
